The Outdoor Learning Cards have been developed by the Outdoor Education Advisers' Panel (OEAP) as a resource to support and inspire teachers and other youth leaders to develop work in the outdoors, with young people, and progress towards the inspirational use of outdoor learning environments.

The Cards, Handbook and CD are delivered through a nationally recognised one-day training course and cover four elements of Outdoor Learning:

- Orienteering.
- Team Building and Problem Solving.
- Bouldering – Use of low level climbing walls.
- Journeying – Local visits organised by young people.

The cards provide information on a range of activities that can be undertaken both on the immediate site and within the local environment. It is intended that this learning resource and associated training programme will provide the foundation that both leaders and young people need to develop their own qualifications and experience to lead them onto more challenging adventures. Indeed, the resources have been developed in partnership with the Duke of Edinburgh's Award scheme and provide a sound foundation for young people wanting to begin the Bronze Award.

These modules can now be used a springboard towards accreditation with Nottingham Trent University. For further details please contact Mike Gorman (LDA).
